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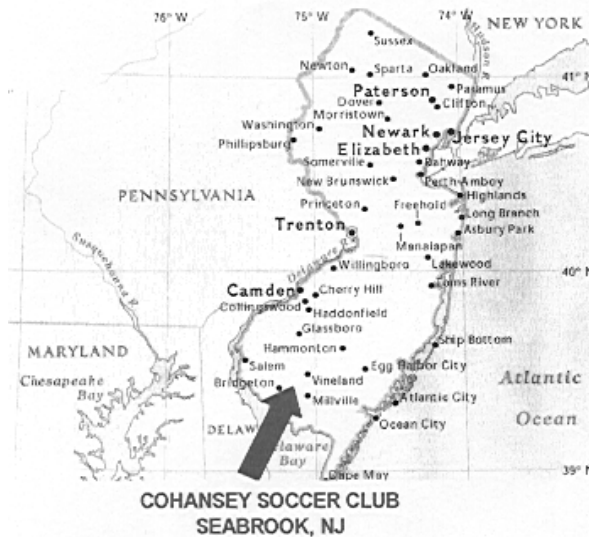
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WHERE IS THE COHANSEY SOCCER CLUB LOCATED?

The **COHANSEY SOCCER CLUB** is located in Seabrook in the heart of scenic southern New Jersey - about 40 miles west of Atlantic City, 30 miles southeast of the Delaware Memorial Bridge, and 30 miles south of Philadelphia. The Tournament includes a **boys traveling team section, a girls traveling team section, and a recreation team section** - - allowing all players at all levels within your club to participate. Last year we hosted **178 teams** from **NJ, PA, DE, VA, and MD**. A similar level of participation is anticipated in this year's event.

Games will be played at the Cohansey Soccer Club Complex and at Cumberland Regional High School in Seabrook, NJ. In addition to having some of the finest fields in the State, our complex also features a concession stand and picnic areas. 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INFORMATION FOR 11 v 11 TRAVELING TEAMS

AGE GROUPS/LEVELS OF PLAY: The 11v11 traveling section of the tournament is open to club teams (*boys and girls traveling teams in the U-11 through U-19 age groups*) that are affiliated with USYSA and/or US Club Soccer and are in good standing with their league and state association.

League Select Teams may also apply. In the event that like competition in an age group is not available, Select Teams will be required to play one age group up from their appropriate age group level.

Teams will be selected and placed based on their league, tournament, and state cup (*where applicable*) records. CSC reserves the right to combine age groups and/or competition levels if a sufficient number of teams does not exist for individual age group and/or separate competition levels.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Each division in each age group will consist of 4 to 8 teams. A minimum of three games will be guaranteed. There will be no finals in divisions that have 4 or 5 teams. First and second place will be decided by order of finish in division play. Finals will be held for divisions that have 6 to 8 teams.

AWARDS: A team trophy and individual player trophies will be presented to the first and second place teams in each 11v11 division in each age group.

Customary patch/pin exchange among players at the conclusion of each game is expected.

LENGTH OF GAMES: All 11v11 games will be scheduled as two 30-minute halves with a five minute half time period.

REFEREES: Appropriately licensed USSF referees will referee each game. Based on the availability of an adequate number of referees, a **three-person referee system** will be used for all 11v11 games.

TEAM ROSTERS: The maximum roster size for all 11v11 teams is **eighteen (18) players**. Teams will be allowed up to **four (4) guest players**. Secondary passes **WILL NOT** be accepted.

A player can only be rostered to one team that is entered into the tournament.

All teams will be required to present their **official roster** for league play, valid **player passes**, and **notarized medical releases** for each player (including guest players) when they register for the Tournament.

A final roster must be submitted at registration.

APPLICATION AND FEES: Each team requesting entry into the tournament must submit the following by **May 1, 2010**.

- Complete Online Registration
- A copy of the team's **official State roster** (*including any player status change -drop/add forms*)
- Entry fee of **\$400 U11-U14, \$450 U15-U19** (*make check payable to CSC, Inc.*)
- For **Out-of-State** teams, a **permission to travel form** from your state association.

INFORMATION FOR 8 v 8 TRAVELING TEAMS

AGE GROUPS/LEVELS OF PLAY: The 8v8 traveling section of the tournament is open to club teams (*boys and girls traveling teams in the U-8 through U-10 age groups*) that are affiliated with USYSA and/or US Club Soccer and are in good standing with their league and state association.

Teams will be selected and placed based on their league and tournament placement/records. CSC reserves the right to combine age groups and/or competition levels if a sufficient number of teams does not exist for individual age group and/or separate competition levels.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Each division in each age group will consist of 4 to 8 teams. A minimum of three games will be guaranteed. **As per NJYSA requirements, all 8v8 play will be non-results oriented.**

AWARDS: **As per NJYSA requirements, all players on all teams will receive participation awards.** Customary patch/pin exchange among players at the conclusion of each game is expected

LENGTH OF GAMES: All 8v8 games will be scheduled as two 25-minute halves with a five minute half time period.

REFEREES: An appropriately licensed USSF referee will referee each game.

TEAM ROSTERS: The maximum roster size for all 8v8 teams is **fourteen (14) players**. Teams will be allowed up to **four (4) guest players**. Secondary passes **WILL NOT** be accepted.

A player can only be rostered to one team that is entered into the tournament.

All teams will be required to present their **official roster** for league play, valid **player passes**, and **notarized medical releases** for each player (including guest players) when they register for the Tournament.

A final roster must be submitted at registration.

APPLICATION AND FEES: Each team requesting entry into the tournament must submit the following by **May 1, 2010**.

- Complete Online Registration
- A copy of the team's **official State roster** (*including any player status change -drop/add forms*)
- Entry fee of **\$350** (*make check payable to CSC, Inc.*)
- For **Out-of-State** teams, a **permission to travel form** from your state association.
